NATIONAL NEWS CONSISTENT WITH LOCAL NEED




"Working women have now lost more than three decades of labor force gains in less than a year. It has especially hurt the women of color who

You help Montoyia feel like she can provide for her kids

Montoyia is a single, stay-at-home mom of 3 diaper age children. She was homeless for about two years until she was referred to one of our partner agencies. When Montoyia arrived, her children were naked and she was using a t-shirt as a diaper for them. She could not afford diapers and was signed up for HappyBottoms that day. She admits, "In the past, I have put a towel down and let my kids sleep



because they would mess their mattress up. At least with HappyBottoms, I know that my kids will always have diapers, even when I don't have money to buy them." When Montoyia doesn't have to worry about where she will get diapers from, she can focus on spending time with her children. She loves watching movies with her children, taking them to the park, and cooking for them. HappyBottoms has allowed Montoyia to have consistency in at least one area of her life and taken the burden of buying diapers off of her shoulders. "When my kids have diapers, I feel like I'm being a good mom who can provide for my kids."
